Mr Mandy said that they are going to use the Masters Gift Card towards helping their children establish fruit and vegetables in the backyard in raised garden beds.

Paul Greenwell took out second place, winning a \$300 Masters Gift Card, with Jack Anderson winning third place taking home a \$100 Masters Gift Card.
